

#### TO LIMERICK VOTERS

For the past 16 years I have been your Solid Waste Manager managing your household trash, being your transfer station manager as well as starting the "take it shop" and at the same time I have been elected 4 times to serve as your selectman for a total of 12 years; but today I am writing this as a concerned citizen.

There are warrant articles on the ballot you will be asked to vote on Tuesday July 14th. These articles concern me very much. I have brought these up during meetings but I realize many of you do not have the internet or social media.

Article 4: Shall the Town of Limerick adopt a policy whereby all members of the Board of Selectmen shall not hold any other town office or any compensated town employment during their tenure of office. The petitioner on the citizens petition didn't even show up for the public hearing to explain why he feels this should pass, at least the voters should know why they should make this important change. To make it clear I was not anticipating running for a 5th term for the office of selectman, I am only concerned for severe consequences should this pass.

The town may be voting out very qualified individuals from serving as a selectman in the future, state law and case law dictates compatibility of elected offices held while being an employee, not dictated by someone's personal agenda. The town attorney has warned in an email to our chairman that the town of Gorham has recently settled a court case allowing an employee to be seated on the Town Council and Yarmouth is currently in litigation with Maine ACLU charged with First Amendment Rights violations.

I think the voters should decide at the ballot box who will or who will not represent them as a selectman and who is or isn't qualified.

Article 5: Shall the Town of Limerick reduce the size of its Board of Selectmen from 5 members to 3 members with each serving a 3 year term; if approved this will become effective March 1, 2021. This will reverse the voter's approval of a five member board three years ago; again no input from the petitioner as to why this should be overturned.

I can tell you from years of experience the town does not want to limit the amount of differing views on its board of selectmen; having a smaller board with little or no experience will be disastrous for our town.

I am not going to tell you how to vote but too think about it before you do vote, have you been given a good enough reason to change these ordinances, especially since the petitioners haven't even explained to you why you should make this change.

#### Article 7 and 8:

You should be advised that State law requires that a recommendation of the board of selectmen and the town's budget committee must accompany any article requesting an appropriation of money on a ballot. In a frenzied rush to get these articles on the ballot this law was not followed, no recommendation appears on the ballot to have the board of selectmen enter into an agreement to purchase property at 29 Main Street for the sum of \$185,000.00 and also an article to hire for \$1,800.00 an engineer to assess buildings on the property after signing an agreement. I urge you to vote no on these two questions until we have a plan accompanied by estimated costs, where will the money come from, condition of buildings and environmental soils evaluation on the property; only then we can move forward to finally construct a new fire station using these informed decisions.

Thank you for your attention to my concerns.







# A friendly \_ reminder...

**Displaying the Confederate flag** serves to celebrate the ownership and enslavement of Black people in America, and the deaths of thousands of American troops. It represents the death of 9,400 Mainers killed (over 3,000 killed in battle) in large part by "rebel" defection.

The Confederacy represented people who chose to no longer be American so that they could continue to enslave and brutalize of black and brown people.

You may fancy yourself a "rebel" but there are other ways to do that than to display the flag of slave-holding insurrectionists.

The Confederate flag largely disappeared after the war but made a comeback throughout the civil rights movements of the 20th Century and was popularized by white opponents of that movement.

Before killing 9 members of a black church in Charleston in 2015, white supremacist terrorist Dylann Roof posed with a Confederate flag.

When you fly the flag, this is the company you keep.

Along with 9,400 dead Mainers, the legacy of the Confederacy is racist violence, terror and misery. In her essay *My Body is a Confederate Monument*, Caroline Randal Williams wrote:

"What is a monument but a standing memory? An artifact to make tangible the truth of the past. My body and blood are a tangible truth of the South and its past. The black people I come from were owned by the white people I come from. The white people I come from fought and died for their Lost Cause. And I ask you now, who dares to tell me to celebrate them?"

[...]

"Either you have been blind to a truth that my body's story forces you to see, or you really do mean to honor the oppressors at the expense of the oppressed, and you must at last acknowledge your emotional investment in a legacy of hate."

# Town of Standish REFERENDUM VOTE TUESDAY, JULY 14, 2020

Question I. To see if the Town will vote to approve a capital expenditure from the Public Safety account by the Municipal Officers of up to \$560,586 for the addition of sleeping quarters to the EMS facility, the acquisition of self-contained breathing apparatus ("SCBA") equipment, and an upgrade to the Town's radio tower equipment, and to authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds and/or bond anticipation notes to include the principal amount of up to \$560,586 for the purpose of financing such expenditures from the proceeds thereof, plus an amount sufficient to refund the interest payments on any bond anticipation notes issued for said purpose, with the dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s) and other details of such borrowing to be determined by the Municipal Officers?

We are currently using a closet and an old storage room on the town hall side of the building as bedrooms for our staff. We are proposing an approximately 24x28 addition for code compliant living quarters, this will also accommodate our college live in students and any future growth. In light of the recent Covid pandemic, it makes this addition even more important.

With changes in the communication world we have poor reception in many parts of the town so we would like to fix the problem by installing 3 simulcast units throughout town that will give us 100% coverage. In 2022 we will be mandated to do so by the FCC, this will help us get a jump on things.

The self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) is the second half of the purchase that was approved last year. Our current units are out of date and soon to be unserviceable, they have a 15-20 year life expectancy (based on the NFPA standards) and ours were purchased in 2002 with a grant.

Question 2. To see if the Town will vote to approve a capital expenditure from the General Administration account by the Municipal Officers of up to \$50,000 for the acquisition of a 1,000 gallon fuel tank, and to authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds and/or bond anticipation notes to include the principal amount of up to \$50,000 for the purpose of financing such expenditures from the proceeds thereof, plus an amount sufficient to refund the interest payments on any bond anticipation notes issued for said purpose, with the dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s) and other details of such borrowing to be determined by the Municipal Officers?

Our gasoline supply tank currently holds 480 gallons and we must have it filled two or three times a week and we often run out in the winter months. Because of this, we are charged more per gallon than most other towns.

We've added Sherriff's deputies over the years. Several of the Public Work's and Public Safety vehicles have been switched (by the manufacturer) back to gas from diesel. This has resulted in far more Gasoline consumption. Our supplier has stated with a 1000-gallon fuel tank we will save a lot on the per gallon price.

Question 3. To see if the Town will vote to approve a capital expenditure from the Public Works account by the Municipal Officers of up to \$229,500 for the purchase of a pick-up truck with plow gear, purchase of an excavator, expansion of the parking lot at the Moody Road facility, and the purchase of a 50-yard roll-off container for single-sort recycling, and to authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds and/or bond anticipation notes to include the principal amount of up to \$229,500 for the purpose of financing such expenditures from the proceeds thereof, plus an amount sufficient to refund the interest payments on any bond anticipation notes issued for said purpose, with the dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s) and other details of such borrowing to be determined by the Municipal Officers?

The proposed pickup truck with a plow will replace a 2007 pickup that has 200,000 miles. The excavator will be a used machine and will replace the Town's 1995 excavator. It will be a larger machine allowing for a greater reach and digging depth. The parking lot expansion for the Public Works facility will provide much needed space for the increased equipment growth in the department. The 50 yard roll-off container is for the single sort recyclables. It will provide an additional container for the weekends at the Transfer Station.

Question 4. To see if the Town will vote to approve a capital expenditure from the Highway Road Improvements account by the Municipal Officers of up to \$815,000 for paving and maintenance to Boundary Road, Harmon's Hill Road, Harmony Drive, Moody Road, Shaws Mill Road, and Thomas Road, and to authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds and/or bond anticipation notes to include the principal amount of up to \$815,000 for the purpose of financing such expenditures from the proceeds thereof, plus an amount sufficient to refund the interest payments on any bond anticipation notes issued for said purpose, with the dates, maturities, denominations, interest rate(s) and other details of such borrowing to be determined by the Municipal Officers?

The Boundary Road was rehabilitated in the fall of 2019. The road was reclaimed, gravel added and base paved. Part of this \$815,000 expenditure is for the surface layer of pavement on the Boundary Road. The remaining roads listed above will be paved after the ditching, tree removals, brush trimming and culvert replacements are completed. These roads were last paved between 1999 and 2006.
